

I read this book to my 5 year old over a month ago. I was impressed with how beautiful it was! There is a story of a grandmother walking in the leaves with her grandchildren that you can read, but each page also highlights a particular tree with a large illustration of that tree's leaf. My son loves books and goes through A LOT of them and moves on. Three days after reading this one to him, he brought it back to me and wanted to show me how he could match all of the leaves to the right trees in the activity section in the back. I was amazed! Then, over a month after reading this book to him, we went on a walk and all he could talk about was bringing leaves home to match them to the book. This book is a great find for feeding young minds....and clearly memorable! And all of those hard to

shop for grandparents, teachers, aunts and uncles are getting a copy of this one for Christmas.

If you're looking for an educational book that is simple and eye-pleasing, this definitely fits the ticket! The illustrations are eye-catching and gorgeous, and the story is simple and beautiful. It is short enough to keep a toddler's attention, yet interesting enough to enthrall an older child (or even adults!). The extra pages at the end where you can try your own hand at matching leaves to their trees are a great addition and make it fun to see what you've learned. This book would make the perfect addition to any parent or grandparent's library!

This is a beautiful book - the art work is wonderful. An extra bonus - 24 trees with their leaves (in fall coloring) are shown. It could be fun to take a child on a fall walk, then come back to this book and see if you can match any leaves you collected with the ones shown in this book. You could then know the names of the leaves you have collected (if you don't already know.) One thing I look for in books to use at storytime is a limited amount of text - one or two lines per page max - and this rhyming book is perfect. Love this book.
