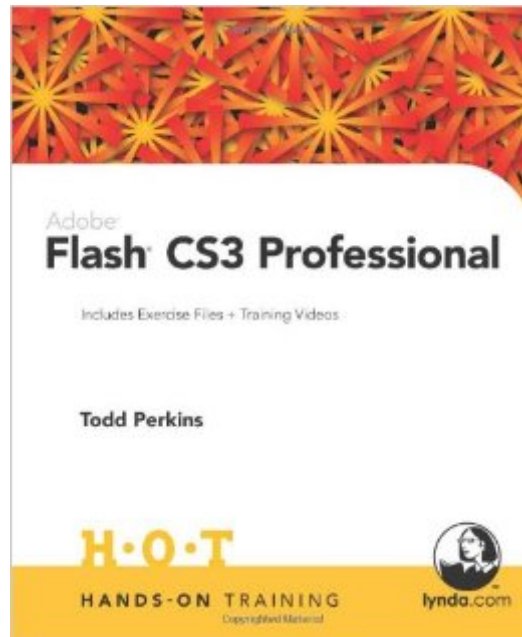

I've used the previous two versions of this book to teach from, as well as this one, and the amount of space devoted in this book to practical applications of Flash is very small. 2 versions back most of the exercises focused on creating a flashed based site and the last two versions get into that less and less - as a matter of fact there is hardly any content in this latest edition that would help a novice build a flash site. Several files were missing or incomplete. Some screenshots were not updated from previous editions where the exercise had changed and the screenshots themselves were very small - no one had a good time trying to read the code in them. Half the books fell apart as well. I'll be looking for another book for next time.

Most Excellent flash textbook I have used. This is not the first Flash class or Flash textbook I have used, but this is the best one. Very good instructions, very clear. Illustrations are great also. Would definitely recommend this book to anyone.

This book is divided into numerous chapters that can be treated as stand-alone references for a given topic. The author provides helpful implementation guidance, decent graphics, and examples. Where I found the book lacking was its lack of flow . . . there really is no narrative that connects the chapters and the deeper instruction that I wanted can only be obtained by bying one of Lynda.com's

instructional DVDs. Any surprise that the book is published by Lynda.com? :-) I recommend you start with "Flash CS3: the Missing Manual" or any of the Flash books published by the ED series. Also, "How to Cheat with Flash CS3" is very helpful.

I bought this book to learn some basic flash to integrate into my websites using Dreamweaver. Little did I know when I bought this book that it was ALL tutorials which you must follow step by step in order to understand the lesson. If you had the idea of reading this book and skipping around a little, forget it. In order to get anything out of this book you are forced to follow along with the activities step by step for 500 + pages. Every new lesson/topic is reliant on you completing all previous lessons and tutorials in the book. In a way it's good- reading this book is the equivalent of taking a class. But it robs the reader of the liberty of learning in the order they prefer and browsing to subjects of interest. Only buy this book if you have the patience to read and follow the 500 pages of tutorials step by step by step...

This is the book version of the Adobe Flash CS3 Essential Training courses on [...], also by Todd Perkins. In printed form, this goes into greater detail. I recently used this book to teach an intro-level class and found it easy to use and well-written. The chapters on ActionScript give a good introduction to programming, especially for people who have little experience. It isn't meant to be comprehensive, but does an effective job of showing how the language interacts with animation on the timeline. The sample code also effectively shows how to do a task different ways. For example, it shows how to load pages of a web site by loading movie clips, then how to load the same pages using linked SWFs. To teach a more detailed class on ActionScript 3, I like Perkins' "ActionScript 3.0 for Adobe Flash CS3". It works with Flash CS4, also. Both of these books are applicable for the Windows and Mac versions, and I have used them to teach classes on both platforms.

This book is a little on the easy side, I would have enjoyed some more challenging examples and tutorials.
