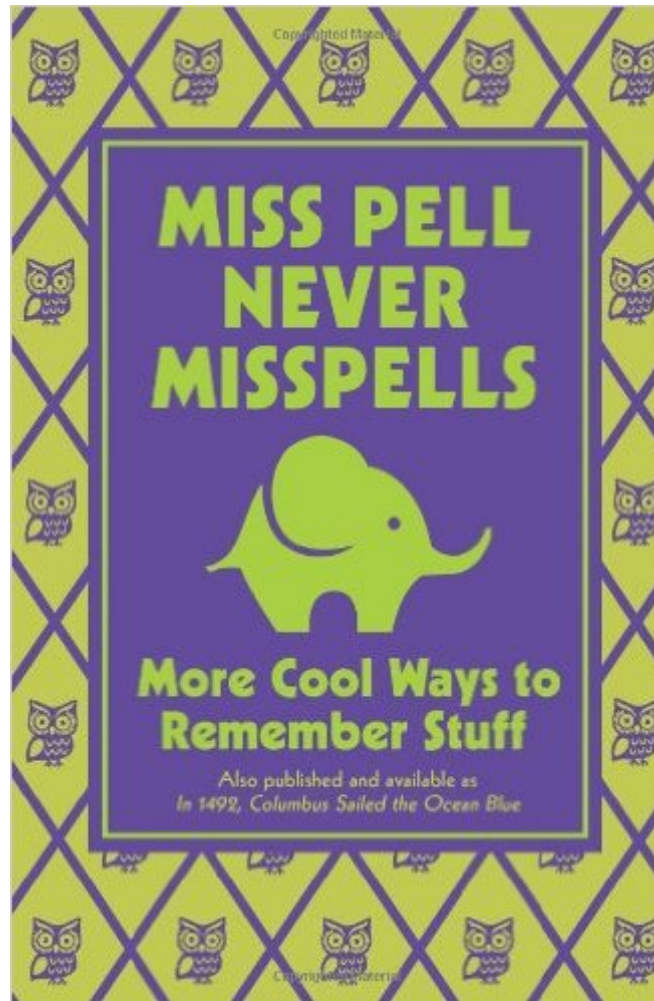

I can only guess the authors used up all the good mnemonics in previous books. Most of the "cool ways" to remember stuff in this book is harder to remember than just remembering what you are trying to learn. For instance, in order to remember the capital of Minnesota you have to remember it is in the third fifth of the states when listed in alpha order, and corresponds to the the third word in the sentence, "Beautiful Ladies Slurp Juicy Jellies Happily, Looking Completely Cool, Too." And that "Slurp" corresponds to "St. Paul". I am not making this up.

Loved this book. Very funny yet educational. I used it with middle school kids to help them remember how to spell those words that puzzle us. This was especially helpful with our non-English speaking students. They laughed and learned!

There are many great memory tricks that are well worth the price of the book if you are trying to teach your kids or a classroom. Most are ones that you would never remember or use. It is the kind of book with phrases that you would probably have to hear several times before they sink in.
