

Builders added highly decorative woodwork called gingerbread in the porch trim, doors and gables. They also added extra turrets, towers, and stained-glass windows."Each house is accompanied by exquisite watercolor rendition of each home gracefully executed by Sarah S. Brannen. The architecture presented ranges from the standard apartment to the more unusual Yurt and Junk House. This would be an excellent choice for classroom use, but may have limited appeal to the individual reader. "What kind of house do you live in?"

This will be very useful for teaching primary grades about different homes in the US and how other children that are less privileged than them live.
