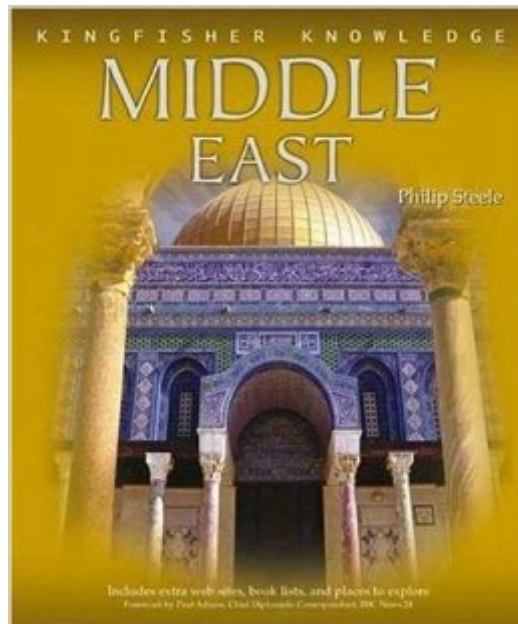

In addition to the information found in the book, The Middle East provides several links to websites and museums with further information on each topic. In my opinion, if you simply want an overview of the Middle East this book satisfies that requirement.
