

This is a lovely book and a favorite of my daughter (now 5) and son (3). It includes a map, andif you know any Mexican geography, you can point out different places mentioned in the book to your kids. It has a lovely flowing rhythm to the words.

We love reading this beautifully illustrated book the shows the story of a family on vacation in Mexico. We read it over and over and dream of Mexico. It's nice that there is both Spanish & English in the book as well.

I bought this before a family trip to Mexico to help my two year old son get excited about the trip. He immediately loved the vibrant illustrations that resemble Mexican folk art and repeats the sing-song rhyming lines of text with me. During our visit he enjoyed identifying the things we had seen each day on our trip in the book such as the Mariachis in the plaza and the pyramids we climbed. Even

after our return this has been in regular rotation at bedtime. The story is simple and highlights different sights, sounds, and events one might see on a trip to Mexico and has a couple pages at the end giving basic facts about the history and language of Mexico.

Such a sweet book with a lilting rhyme and words in Spanish at the bottom. Great read for all children. Colorful illustrations kids love.

I just got this book for my 3 year old daughter. We are both equally mesmerized by the colorful images; you can practically hear the music and feel the warm sun just flipping through the pages.
