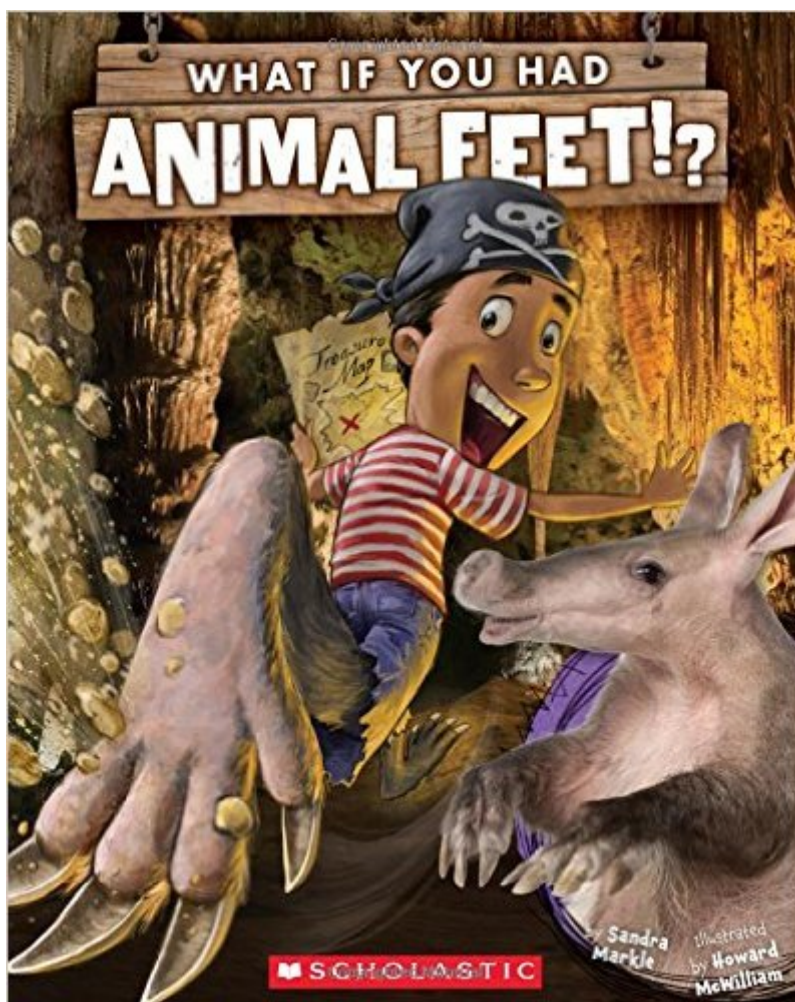

I had different samples of the different kinds of feet and they glued them to the bottom of the writing sample. The book was really cute and informational. I read this last week to my grandson's 2nd grade class, and they loved it!!!! I did something that

made it more fun, I think. The format of this book is the left side has the "non-fiction" facts about a particular animal, and the right page, has a picture of a child with that animal's teeth. To keep the "surprise," I covered the right side of the book so the class couldn't see the picture of child until they heard the fact page, and then I took the cover off. It worked exactly as I hoped! They loved the surprise rather than looking at that picture while I read the facts on the left. A real hit...
