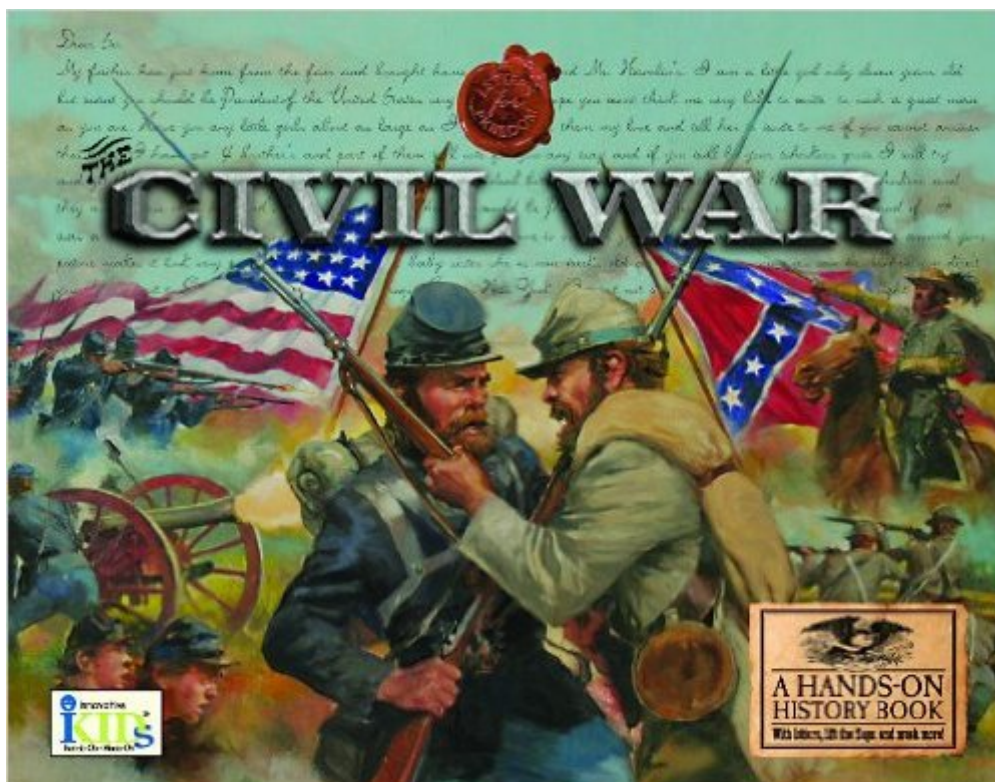

He likes that it is an interactive book that has flaps, slides, etc - but not in a baby pop up book type way. It is definitely not written for little kids. It is perfect for the ages of 11-14.
